WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOU'RE BUILDING

uilding a custom home or undertaking a major renovation can be a fun and exciting experience if you know what to expect. - If needed, meet with your banker to discuss and secure financing.
- Select an architect or home designer who will help bring your vision to life on paper.
- □ Interview and hire a custom designbuild team (builder, interior designer, landscaper) responsible for creating your one-of-a-kind dream home based on your lifestyle and budget.
- Acquire building permits. Often a task performed by your general contractor, the permitting process will vary based on which community you have chosen to build in.
- Prepare site and pour foundation. This can be a relatively simple or complex undertaking depending on the location of your lot and whether you need a septic system.

- □ Framing, including floors, walls and roofing. The crucial "bones" of your home should be solid and long-lasting, making it even more critical to select a custom build team that employs only the highest quality craftsman.
- □ Insulation, plumbing, electrical and HVAC. Here in the Park City area, where temperatures can vary dramatically depending on the time of year, quality insulation as well as a good heating and cooling system is critical not only for comfort, but for energy efficiency.
- □ Complete drywall and interior textures; begin exterior finishes and install exterior driveway and walkways. Your home's exterior should reflect your personal style and fit in with the natural surroundings. A great designer can help create your home's unique first impression that also complements the warmth and style of the interior.

<u>Trending Now</u> Cut your Home's Carbon Footprint Without Cutting into Style

odern home-builders have taken on eco-friendly home design, driven by facts like: "39% of the energy used in the country are in the residential and commercial sectors". Moreover, our custom home builders are successfully taking on this challenge without sacrificing curb appeal.

The latest, eco-friendly building trend, and a word that you'll be hearing more often is Net-Zero energy design, or a building capable of utilizing Eco-friendly elements with less need for traditional powersources like natural gas, oil or electricity. The most significant variable in this equation for new homes are solar panels and window orientation.

Solar panels are especially effective in areas that receive a lot of sun, like Park City, Sun Valley or Scottsdale. Solar panels work by absorbing natural sunlight with photovoltaic cells, generating direct current (DC) energy and then converting it to usable alternating current (AC) energy with the help of inverter technology. Photovoltaic cells absorb the sun's energy and convert it to DC electricity. Though solar panels are an amazing progressive invention they aren't very visually appealing. Your designer and builder need to consider which direction roof angles should face so solar panels are least visible (increasing curb appeal) and receiving the most sunlight (increasing energy efficiency).

Now when it comes to windows, home builders study design plans, noting where the greatest and

least windows are, and how to plot location and local weather impact on the home. Essentially, in hot climates, the sides of the house with the *least* windows face the sunniest directions; where in cold climates, the sides of the house with the *most* windows face the greatest sun exposure. Throughout this directional orientation process, it is also achievable to capture that highly-desired asset—natural light.

If you're looking to conduct a green-minded remodel of your existing home, you obviously can't just helicopter your house off its foundation and re-orient it. In a remodel, first replace your old, inefficient windows with high-efficiency ones. Timeworn windows are often culprits in wasteful thermal flow. Beyond windows, consider swapping out your old appliances with new, cost-effective, and ecologically resourceful ones—luxury appliances are both eye-catching and sleek.

As we continue to see how much Net-Zero home design benefits the world we live in and decreases are dependence on coal and fossil fuels, choosing to *go green* will become the choice of modern home builds without sacrificing beautiful design.

For a less traditional look, concrete can be paved into irregular shapes, or have other materials like bricks or pavers incorporated in linear patterns, or random or fanciful design. You might want to consider adding a grass strip down the middle of the concrete if you live in an area with consistent precipitation. Grass can improve your driveway's drainage due to the permeability of grass.

Despite its adaptability, concrete has a serious competitor in asphalt, especially when it comes to harsh winter climates. Contrary to concrete, asphalt is not as prone to expansion and contraction, which can cause damage and deterioration. Asphalt also

absorbs warmth from the sun more efficiently, and that heat helps to melt ice off driveways improving overall safety. Furthermore, asphalt makes an excellent driveway material choice for another big reason—asphalt is eco-friendly. Because asphalt can be crushed up and recycled, it is the perfect option for those who desire an environmentally conscious driveway design.

From concrete to pavers to bricks and asphalt, you can take all the advice the world has to give. In the end, however, you pave your way in deciding what material(s) will make your driveway envy of the neighborhood while simultaneously reflecting on what defines your contentment with the end product. It's a balancing act, to be sure, but one that'll result in the coolest, most practical driveway on the block. IM
